

KEY: 1 = 11 UNIQUE COLUMNS

- SPEED:** Horses that have taken the lead in a race within 75 days.
- PRESS:** Horses that have pressed the leader in a race within 75 days.
- STALK:** Horses that have sat at least a length, but less than 4 of the lead within 75 days.
- CLOSE:** Horses that have raced at least 4 lengths off the lead within 75 days.
- WORKS:** Rates workouts that were against a minimum of 18 horses within 60 days.
- RIDER:** Finds the best rating with today's assigned jockey within 365 days.
- @DIST:** Finds the best rating at today's distance within 365 days.
- TURF:** Finds the best rating each horse has run on turf within 365 days.
- TRACK:** Finds the best rating each horse has achieved at today's track within 365 days.
- ROUTE:** Finds the best "stretch" run rating for each horse within 75 days.
- PURSE:** Finds each horses best effort within 75 days and prints the purse money value.

- 2 =** The top pick is the best **STALKER** within 75 days.
The middle pick is the best **SPEED** within 75 days.
The bottom pick is the best **CLOSER** within 75 days.
- 3 =** The top pick is the best in the **@DIST** column.
The middle pick is the best in the **RIDER** column.
The bottom pick is the best in the **TRACK** column.
- 4 =** The top pick is the **BEST** horse in the horse graph report.
The middle pick is the 2nd best horse in the horse graph report.
The bottom is the 3rd best horse in the horse graph report.
- 5 =** This is the pace forecast; it gives the likely pace scenario for the start of each race based on current form.
- 6 =** This is the photo forecast; it gives the forecasted finish of each race based on current form.

Black boxes highlight the best contenders in each race based on their running style, talents, current form, works, and or past performance. Your own handicapping may lead you to choose any of the four horses, or none of the four horses when making your final selections.

SYMBOLS

-  This horse with its legs spread out represents horses that are gaining on the front end or drawing away from the field at that point of the race.
-  This horse with its legs tucked in represents horses that are losing ground whether on the lead or behind.
- \$** If you see the \$ sign before a horses saddlecloth number, this indicates the horse was claimed within the last 60 days, but has not won for it new owners.
- :** If you see a colon sign after a horses saddlecloth number, this indicates the horse is a first time starter.
- .** If you see a period after a horses saddlecloth number, this indicates the horse has been entered at its best possible distance.
